On <u>Sunday</u>, <u>Nov. 2 at 10:15AM</u> we will celebrate **All Saints' Sunday** at Saint Paul UCC. The Memorial Committee will serve as greeters and communion celebrants for this special day of worship. Nancy Schneider, Council Member and chair of the Memorial Team, will serve as lector. She will read Revelation 7:9-17; the epistle reading from 1 John 3:1-3. Matthew 5:1-12, a portion of the Beatitudes, is the grounding for the day's message. Terri Huber will serve as acolyte at the communion table as we light the candles of a menorah. Meet Ryan Henkel! (article below ran in the Denver Forum)

Ryan Henkel, a second-year student at Wartburg College studying Religion: Pre-Seminary, has been asked by Saint Paul United Church of Christ in Denver to help offer and build a youth program option for members and new friends in the Denver community. Youth ages 12-17 are expected to form the core of the group.

A native of Pontiac, Illinois, located near the heart of Illinois near Bloomington, Ryan has been involved with many different youth groups and has led numerous worship services. At Wartburg College, he sings and has toured with the Wartburg Choir, the Ritterchor (a men's choir, meaning "Knight's Choir"), and also serve as the Eucharist Worship Team Coordinator, a student-led Wednesday evening service. He may have met many of our Denver students while serving as a Counselor at EWALU this past summer, which he says "was a blast, to say the least." Ryan envisions that he and Saint Paul UCC will offer a safe place for youth to come and learn about the Bible and Jesus, and just take a break from all of the stress in students' daily lives.

He'll begin serving on Sun. Nov. 2, initially offering a youth gathering at the traditional Sunday Schoolhour of 9-10AM, before 10:15AM worship. Some youth may find it a better fit to join in at 6PM on many Sunday evenings this autumn for an informal gathering that will follow a theme like love, courage, or justice, with fun and fellowship. All youth in the community are invited and welcome. Bring a friend! Initially, gatherings (morning or evening) are planned for Sundays, Nov. 2, 9, 16; Nov 23 (a meet/greet at 6PM and then join the Ecumenical Thanksgiving Service at 6:30PM in the sanctuary); and Dec. 7 and 14. There will be no youth Sun. School or gathering on Nov. 30 (Ryan is rehearsing for Christmas at Wartburg then!); and the youth group will take a break in late December/early January). Later, Ryan suggests that Wednesday evenings may offer an occasional good fit, but Saint Paul UCC and Ryan will offer Sunday evenings as a start.
